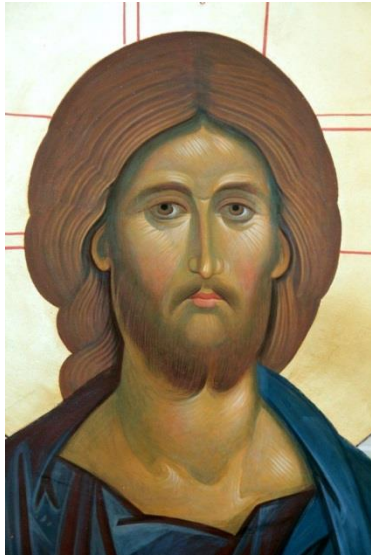


The 2017-2018 Catholic/Orthodox Book Club
